Dinner will be @ 5:30 pm at the "Waterfront Pub and Eatery" in Delavan located at 408 State Rd. 50, Delavan WI. 53115. (262-728-4700) Special parking in lot between the restaurant and car lot. If you like you can visit them on the web. <http://www.delavanwaterfront.com/> or Facebook. You can check out their menu which should be the same during our visit in May.

For those interested there is a 1987 Yellow Corvette 2/owner, 73000 m./auto trans./ for sale on the car lot for \$7500. Just something the restaurant owners mentioned.

For the Hotel stay please bring a **dessert/light snack** to pass for the hospitality room and whatever beverage you wish to drink.

There is a pool so don't forget your swimsuits.

Directions: **32/57 south** out of DePere towards Greenleaf staying on 32/57 through Hilbert, Chilton, New Holstein, until **Hwy 67 South**, in Kiel Wisconsin. Take **67 South** to "Elkhart Lake/Plymouth". In Plymouth "**67**" **South** to **CTY. "C"** (Mill St.) turn left; take this to "Kwik Trip" 2480 Eastern Ave. which is "**C**". ******Gas station stop here due to lack of facilities in the next several miles******. Leave this stop continue on "**C**" to "**E**" turn right continue to "**C**"/**PP west** to "**67 South**" to "**Cty "A" South**. Stay on **Cty "A"**. Cty F and **Cty A** come to a "T", turn right to continue on **Cty A**. Approximately ½ mile **Cty A** turns left. We continue to and through Beechwood, stay straight on **Cty HH** (where HH & Cty A split) to **Jct D**. Take a right turn towards New Fane; In New Fane, take a left on **Cty S** and continue where **Cty S** will again turn left, towards Kewaskum. Turn right on **Hwy 45** to **Hwy 28** left on **Hwy 28** (west) towards **175**, crossing over Hwy 141, past wetlands to **Hwy 175** left (south) to Theresa. In and through Theresa to **67 South** turn right. Mayville has a Vets Memorial on the left side at the end of a bridge on the river, past Mayville Park Pavilion and continue on Hwy 67 South towards Oconomowoc. At the 4 way stop, continue straight on **67 South** towards **Neosho**. **(There is a BP "Good Old Gas" on the right where we could stop for gas and bathroom break, parking seems adequate)**. Continue on 67 south past Honey Acres in Old Ashippun, on to Ashippun, past Ewald Soccer Field. **Hwy 67** turns left with Hwy 16 east toward Oconomowoc where there is Culvers located on Hwy 67. **(Stop for lunch at Culvers)**.

Continue on **67 South** through Oconomowoc to **Hwy B**, turn right (west) pass Target Corp offices. Straight ahead on **Hwy B** you will see Silver Lake, road curves around past Burkes Lakeside, and around lake to **Cty BB**, turn left (south) continue on **Cty BB** to end, turn right onto **Hwy 18** to 2nd **Cty E** by Mobil Station turn left to continue on Cty E. Continue to **Hwy CI**, turn left to **Hwy Z** continue until **Hwy H**, turn right (south), and continue on Hwy H, to Palmyra. Pass Bald Bluff Scenic overlook, John Muir trails straight across Hwy 12, General Store on left. Stay on **Cty H** to the left (w/Cty A) then Cty H to the right (1/2 mi) continue on Pass green quilt barn, to Walworth County Bldg. (N. Church/Cty H) Elkhorn turn right on Hwy 11/Wisconsin Street past Landmark Bldg., into Delavan which will be approximately 3 ½ miles. Continue on Hwy 11 west at Citgo at Wright Street turn left past Pentairz Corp, Shopper Advertising, and turn right by Auto

zone to Hotel. We should arrive around 3pm to check in at the Hotel. We can do what we like until dinner @ 5:30 PM, swim, socialize, rest or drive to Lake Geneva down **“State Road 50”** to enjoy the view. The drive would depend on the time of course. If we make good time and arrive in Delavan earlier than 3pm we can make the drive to Lake Geneva, it's only about 15 minutes away. We will make use of the hospitality room after dinner or we can wing it once we arrive at our destination and decide as a group.
