

First and foremost, allow me to extend a sincere "Thank You" to all members of the Car Show Committee. I know first-hand that the Car Show Committee put in a TON of work to make the Car Show the huge success that it was.



As we've discussed at a few meetings, a motion was made to amend the Bylaws to potentially change the time of the Monthly Meetings. As proposed, the Amendment would allow the Board of Directors to set, at the beginning of each year, the Meeting time for each month of that particular year. As an example, the Board would meet in January of 2017 and establish the starting time for each monthly meeting for the 2017 year. Thus, certain Monthly Meetings (e.g. during the winter months) could be at 7:00 p.m., while others may still stay at the 8:00 p.m. timeframe. Members will have two ways to vote: 1) by sending in the ballot that will be contained in the September Newsletter, or 2) by voting in person at the October Meeting. Please remember – in order to pass, the Amendment would need to be approved by two-thirds of all Members of the Club (not just those present at the October meeting). More information is provided within this Month's Newsletter.

We have lots of events coming up this month (and next), so please make sure to check out the "Events" tab on the Club Website (http://www.corvettesofthebay.org/events.php). The information gets updated frequently, so check often!

Finally, I know it's only July, but elections for Board Members and Officers will be coming up very quickly. As I mentioned, I will not be running for President next year – I feel that "changing things

up" every few years is a good thing to do, and I know there are some Members in the Club who would make a fantastic President. I encourage each of you to run for an Officer or Board position. If you would like more information, please reach out to any of the current Board Members and we will get you whatever information you may need.

Bylaw Amendment to Allow Board of Directors to Set Meeting Time

In accordance with the Bylaws, during the July 2016 meeting, a written proposal was submitted to the Secretary that was signed by 10 members in good standing requesting that Section 4.07 of the Bylaws be amended to state as follows:

"Regular monthly meetings shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month. The Board of Directors shall set and communicate to the Members, by no later than January 15th of each year, the start time for each monthly meeting for remainder of such calendar year and January of the following year (e.g., the Board shall set, in January at the commencement of that Board's term, the start time for each of the monthly meetings for the following February - January)."

The proposed Amendment was presented to the Club, and opened for comments, questions, suggestions, and general discussion at the June and July 2016 Monthly Member Meetings. Voting may be made via written ballot and via in-person ballot voting at the October Monthly Member Meeting. If you prefer to vote prior to the October Meeting, ballots (along with instructions for submitting your ballot) will be provided in the August and September Newsletters. Ballots will be provided at the October Monthly Member meeting for anyone who does not vote prior to that meeting.

Passage of the Amendment requires a "Yes" vote by 2/3 of all paid Members of the Club (failure to vote is equivalent to a "No" Vote).
