This month's MOD Corner comes from Corey Romasko



So, after the passing of my beloved C5 and the purchase of the Z you can imagine what the first major mod was. Exhaust valves!

So after pulling the top of the block apart and getting the heads off I had only one machine shop in mind, West Coast Cylinder Heads out of California. They have a great reputation and if Katech uses them, you know they must be doing something right. Since the heads were off I figured this was a good time to add a few ponies while strengthening up the valve train. Along with SS exhaust valves and bronze guides, I had the heads milled, competition port and polish done, and installed some BTR dual titanium valve springs. Now my darling love is healthy and strong all the way to 7000 Rpm!
