Call to order: President Dan Terrien called the meeting to order at 7:02pm at The Village Grille in Bellevue, WI with 115 members in attendance.

#### Approval of May Minutes as posted:

President Dan called for a motion to approve the May minutes as posted in the newsletter. Motion was made by Rick Northrop, motion carried.

Terri Villiesse reported the status of the club's assets and last month's sales of the Shell gas cards and Kwik Trip car wash cards. Great accomplishment, Greg! 2004 C-5 Corvette

A License to Thrill!

**Owner: Harry Liebergen** 



Harry Liebergen may have the shortest resume in history. Two simple but sensational words describe Harry's 60 years of Corvette craftmanship...Mr. Vette! Those words adorn the license plate of Harry's flawless 2004 C-5 Corvette but, more importantly, his custom license plate symbolizes the 134 Corvettes Harry has owned in his lifetime and the hundreds more than he has restored, painted or customized over the past 6 decades as the owner of the legendary Green Bay shop Painted by Harry Liebergen.

Harry was still in grade school when the Corvette debuted in 1953, but he quickly made up for lost time. 134 Corvettes later, Harry is just as excited to see the mext one as he was to see the first one at the age of 20 when he purchased a stock '62 Corvette. His zest for Vettes hasn't cooled over the past 6 decades though he is down to three these days, a 1964 Sting Ray convertible, a 1956 Custom Corvette and this all-original C-5 which is 1 of just 2,641 yellow Corvettes produced in 2004 out of a total run of 34,064. Harry uncovered this gem in lola, WI with a mere 7500 miles on the clock in 2021 and has made it an old friend by nearly doubling the miles in the time since.

The engine in Harry's Corvette is like a pair of well-worn house slippers, always dependable and ready for the next destination. The venerable 5.7 Liter LS1 V-8 packs a punch with 350 horsepower and 375 lb. ft. of torque. It can certainly hold its own against modern day muscle with a 0-50 time of 5 seconds and a top speed of 175 mph.

While Harry's 2004 Corvette is deserving of this special display for the Corvettes of the Bay, Harry himself

deserves to be honored. He was one of the founding members of Corvettes of the Bay in 1974 and has remained a member in good standing ever since as the club will soon celebrate its 50th birthday. If you happen to run up behind a yellow Corvette and see "Mr. Vette" on the license plate just smile and wave to a man who truly has a License to Thrill!
