Corvettes of the Bay Monthly Meeting Minutes November 7, 2023

Call to Order/Silence Phones:

President Dan Terrien called the meeting to order at 7:00pm at The Village Grille in Bellevue, WI with 89 members in attendance.

Motion to Approve October Meeting Minutes:

President Dan called for a motion to approve the October minutes as posted in the newsletter. Motion was made by Ed Villiesse; motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Terri Villiesse

Terri Villiesse reported the status of the club's assets and last month's sales of the Shell gas cards and Kwik Trip car wash cards. Membership is currently at 245 paid members; 43 singles, 101 duals, and 4 honorary members. President Dan called for a motion to approve the treasurer's report; motion was made by Vicki Blahnik; motion carried.

Membership:

New/Potential Members or Guests in attendance - None at this meeting.

We are taking membership renewals now. Memberships that come in now are good through December 31st, 2024.

Board of Directors and Election Clarification:

President Dan reports that normally the club election is held for the next board of directors at the November meeting and the new board is announced at the December meeting. This year the number of candidates matched the number of open positions, so no election was held. Tony Yaggie is your President-elect and Guy Ringle is your Vice-President-elect. Their terms begin in January, and January 2nd will be the first meeting Tony will run.

Annual Budget:

Section 5.13 of the By-Laws says the Board will prepare a budget to be discussed and approved by members at the "annual meeting" which is the December member meeting. "Modifications to the budget can be voted on by the members to reflect changes in income, membership interest or unique opportunities." The Board will be meeting prior to our December 5th member meeting to prepare this.

- The Member of the Year will be awarded at our Christmas party January 5, 2024.

Corvette Related Videos – Dan Terrien on behalf of Greg Rohde:

- · Greg has hunted for Corvette related videos over the past few years to enhance our meetings.
- Content primarily includes history of the Corvette, Corvette racing and industry news. One of Greg's goals is to mix up the meetings with information not everyone knows and add something you can't find in the newsletter or on our website.

Meeting Considerations:

C8 Corvette Z51 Sting Ray

From Old School to Racing School!











Corvettes of the Bay member Carol Jacobs wasn't any stranger to Corvette culture when her 2021 Elkhart Lake Blue C8 Corvette Z51 finally arrived. Carol cut her teeth on piston pounding 1970s Muscle Cars with a pure passion for the earlier breed of Corvettes. Her first Vette was an old school Steel Cities Gray 1971 T-top that she kept for 21 years but, when she eventually parted ways, Carol waded her way through multiple generations of Corvettes waiting for her passion to fit the fashion. An average weeknight November 7th, 2019, turned into an internet adventure when Carol found herself ordering the newly designed and highly anticipated mid-engine C8 Corvette. When her fingers finished flying across the keyboard, she had added the \$5000 Z51 performance package which added a sportier suspension setup, beefed-up Brembo brakes, stickier tires and, oh yes, and another 5 horsepower.

The wait was agony, but the result was ecstasy. Carol remained patiently parked on the sidelines for a full 501 days awaiting the arrival of her Elkhart Lake Blue C8 Z51 Corvette. Delays included an eternal list of back orders caused by COVID, but the magical day finally came March 23rd, 2021, when she took delivery from Gandrud Chevrolet in Green Bay, WI. As if the sinister black wing rising out of the rear isn't evidence enough, this soft top isn't any soft touch. The 6.2 Liter 2LT V-8 is tuned like a Stradivarius and backs up its sweet sound with a 0-60 time of 2.9 seconds and a top speed of 194 mph! The C8 Z51 makes a strong argument for being the best Sportscar in the world for the investment.

With a 495 HP powerplant with 470 lb.·ft. of torque inches behind her head, Carol had no intention of turning her stallion into a parade pony. She jumped at Chevrolet's invitation to attend the two-day Ron Fellows Performance Driving School in Pahrump, Nevada. Over those 48 hours, Carol carved up the corners and tested the limits of her Sting Ray's 8-speed dual clutch transmission. Exactly 50 years separated Carol's first Covette from her C8 Z51 as she made the quantum leap from "Old School to Racing School". Motor Trend Magazine made the C8 its Car of the Year, Carol made hers the car of a lifetime!
