Corvettes of the Bay Monthly Meeting Minutes

December 5, 2023

Call to Order/Silence Phones:

President Dan Terrien called the meeting to order at 7:01pm at The Village Grille in Bellevue, WI with 94 members in attendance.

Motion to Approve November Meeting Minutes:

President Dan called for a motion to approve the November minutes as posted in the newsletter. Motion was made by Dan Brunmeier; motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Terri Villiesse:

Terri Villiesse reported the status of the club's assets and last month's sales of the Shell gas cards and Kwik Trip car wash cards. Membership is currently at 246 paid members; 42 singles, 102 duals, and 4 honorary members. President Dan called for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. Motion was made by Rick Northrop; motion carried.

Membership:

- New/Potential Members or Guests in attendance None at this meeting.
- We are taking membership renewals now. Memberships that come in now are good through December 31st, 2024. Commemorative COTB 50th anniversary window clings will be given to members this evening with a paid membership.

2024 Annual Budget:

The Board has prepared a budget to be discussed and approved by members today, our "annual meeting" – Terri Villiesse. Terri reviewed the 2024 annual budget in detail. President Dan asked for a motion to approve the 2024 annual budget. Motion was made by Liz Kelling; motion carried.

Meeting Place:

President Dan reports the Board discussed other possible meeting locations, and decided to maintain our relationship with The Village Grille. We will likely be moving back to the main Village Grille location (Hoffman Road) during the months of January – April 2024. The Board will communicate with Cathy, the owner, and confirm January meeting location later this month.

Past Runs and Events:

- November 11 Green Bay Yacht Club 19th Annual Veteran's Day Commemoration: William Miehe. Bill reports this was a last minute event, but there were five Corvettes and three members who are Veterans. The group met at the Yacht Club at 10:00am, there were approximately 200 people in attendance along with dignitaries, music, food, coffee, and gun salutes. There has been discussion to continue this event in the future. - November 18 Muscle Car and Corvette Nationals in Rosemont, IL: Darrell Bringe and Mark Finco. Mark reports this was an outstanding event. There were cars from Canada, the NCRS was present, and the "barn find" section had some rare cars.
