MPI WJW has over a hundred employees with six different buildings scattered throughout Neenah and Appleton. MPI WJW own their own chrome shop, interior shop, mechanical shop, paint and body shop nothing leaves their roof to make the restoration seamless. The latest acquisition is Corvette Sports out of Sheboygan, where they restore Corvettes through Classic Mechanics and Motion Products.
