2001 Chevrolet Corvette

The connection between Corvettes and country is patriotism at its purest! It was Cynthia and Damian Schumacher's deep affection for America and America's sports car that inspired them to celebrate our nation's upcoming 250th birthday with a special traveling tribute. Using their Speedway White 2001 Chevrolet Corvette as the canvas, they teamed with Brittany Kurtz of Vital Signs to create an impressive portrait of patriotism. The hood and trunk wear majestic eagles in flight while ribbons of red, white, and blue flow down each side accented by another eagle, the American flag, and Declaration of Independence.

This Corvette couple's devotion to their country and Corvettes runs deep. Purchased from Buyavette, Inc. in Atlanta, this '01 Corvette has everything Cynthia and Damian had on their wish list with its Speedway White exterior, Light Oak leather interior, 4-speed automatic and convertible top. This C5 is completely stock except for adding a little chorus to the baritone exiting the exhaust system with upgraded mufflers. An even sweeter sound comes from people shouting "America!" as they drive through towns creating Miles of Smiles!

Chevrolet did its part to add to that symphony of sound in 2001 with the introduction of the 5.7-liter LS6 V8 unleashing 385 horsepower and 360 lb. ft. of torque. All that power is kept in check by a hydroformed frame providing passengers with a quieter and smoother ride over previous Corvettes. Weight distribution improved dramatically by shifting the transmission to the rear of the car. All those major improvements played out on the racetrack making 2001 a landmark year. The Corvette won 8 of 10 major races in 2001, including an overall win in the 24 Hours of Daytona and a one-two finish in the GTS class at Le Mans.

Just as Cynthia and Damian Schumacher honor our country's 250th birthday, The Automobile Gallery & Event Center is proud to honor the Schumachers for their decades-long devotion to the Corvettes of the Bay club dating back to 1996.
