



The purpose of this Privacy Policy ("Policy") is to establish the manner in which Corvettes of the Bay, Inc. ("COTB") collects personal information of its members, including how such information is used, and how such information is protected. Information includes, without limitation, your name, mailing address, email address, telephone number and other similar information. No personal financial information is entered or stored on the COTB website. Information may be provided by you through the initial COTB Membership Application, updates to the COTB website, and any other method(s) by which you transmit information to COTB. By providing such information to COTB, you agree that such information may be used by COTB, and other members of COTB, to contact you regarding COTB business and events and for social/personal reasons. Unless you instruct COTB, in writing, of your objection, your information will appear in the COTB Membership roster which is located on COTB's website. Your information is accessible on the website by current members of COTB through the use of a unique User ID and password. You are responsible for all actions taken with your User ID and password.

The membership roster is for official COTB use and also for individual communication of a personal nature between members of COTB. Use of the membership roster (or the information contained therein) by you for any other purpose, including but not limited to (a) reproducing and storing such information in a retrieval system by any electronic or mechanical means, (b) photocopying, or (c) for any solicitation for business purposes, is strictly prohibited and in direct violation of COTB policy. COTB may release your information to applicable parties if doing so is required under applicable law (e.g., subpoena, court order, etc.).

For privacy reasons COTB employs reasonable procedural and technical safeguards on the website to protect your information against loss, theft, and unauthorized disclosure. While COTB uses such reasonable safeguards, COTB makes no guarantee as to the safety, security, or privacy of information displayed or stored on the website. By providing such information to COTB, you acknowledge the risk that such information may be obtained by third parties and you agree not to hold COTB responsible for any breach of such safeguards or for unauthorized access to your information by such third parties.

By attending COTB events, you agree that COTB has permission to publish, on the website, in COTB publications, and in any other print or video media deemed appropriate by COTB, your image (picture), your name, and information about your Corvette. You agree to waive any right to inspect such media prior to publication, and acknowledge that you shall be entitled to no royalties or other compensation for the use of such image, name, or information.
